Israel and Iran trade strikes amid diplomacy

JERUSALEM

EUROPEAN powers began talks with Iran in Geneva on Friday, talking of a window of opportunity for a diplomatic solution while the United States weighs whether to join its ally Israel's bombing campaign.

Israel came under renewed Iranian missile fire after carrying out dozens of strikes overnight on targets, including a suspected nuclear research centre. Top European diplomats opened talks with Iranian Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi in Geneva, saying they wanted to offer a "diplomatic solution" to the war, now on its eighth day.

Ahead of the talks, French President Emmanuel Macron said it was "essential to prioritise" a return to negotiations, and said European powers would offer Iran a "diplomatic solution".

Israel's military said on Friday it struck missile launchers in its latest attack on Iran. In Israel, sirens sounded in the afternoon after missiles were launched from Iran for the second time on Friday, and rescuers reported two wounded, including a 16-year-old in serious condition. Missiles fired from Iran on Friday left at least 19 people injured in the northern Israeli



port of Haifa, a local hospital.

A military official said that "approximately 20 missiles were launched towards Israel" in the latest salvo. At least 25 people have been killed in Israel since the war began, according to Israeli authorities. Iran said Sunday that Israeli strikes had killed at least 224 people, including military commanders, nuclear scientists and civilians. Authorities have not issued an updated toll since. In Israel, the paramedic service Magen David Adom, or MDA, said Iranian missiles struck a residential area in southern Israel causing damage to buildings, including one six-story building. Residential areas in both countries have suffered, while Israel and Iran have traded accusations of targeting civilians.

Trump to decide within 2 weeks whether to join war

BEERSHEBA: President Donald Trump said Thursday he will decide within two weeks whether the US military will get directly involved in the conflict between Israel and Iran given the "substantial chance" for renewed negotiations over Tehran's nuclear programme, as the two sides attacked one another for a seventh day. Trump has been weighing whether to attack Iran by striking its well-defended Fordo uranium enrichment facility, which is buried under a mountain and widely considered to be out of reach of all but America's "bunker-buster" bombs. Earlier in the day, Israel's defense minister threatened Iranian Supreme Leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei after Iranian missiles crashed into a major hospital in southern Israel and hit residential buildings near Tel Aviv, wounding at least 240 people. The United States issued new Iran-related sanctions Friday, taking aim at the procurement of machinery for the country's defense industry at a time when war is flaring in the Middle East. AP

IAEA warns hit on Bushehr risks nuclear disaster

THE Middle East risks a nuclear catastrophe if Israel strikes Iran's southern nuclear plant of Bushehr, the head of the UN atomic watchdog warned Friday. Rafael Grossi, director of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA), told the UN Security Council that he has not yet detected radiation resulting from Israel's week-long military campaign against Iran, including attacks on nuclear sites. But he said that a strike on Bushehr—the Middle East's first civilian nuclear reactor, which so far appears to have been spared—would spell the most serious consequences as it contains thousands of kilograms of nuclear material. "Countries of the region have reached out directly to me over the past few hours to express their concerns, and I want to make it absolutely and completely clear—in case of an attack on the Bushehr nuclear power plant, a direct hit would result in a very high release of radioactivity," Grossi said. Israeli forces kill 60, half near aid centres

GAZA CITY

Gaza's civil defence agency said 31 Palestinian aid seekers were among at least 60 people killed Friday by Israeli forces, the latest in a string of deadly incidents near aid distribution sites. Civil defence spokesman Mahmud Bassal told AFP that five people were killed while waiting for aid in the southern Gaza Strip and 26 others near a central area known as the Netzarim corridor, an Israeli-controlled strip of land that bisects the Palestinian territory.

The Israeli army told AFP that its troops in the Netzarim area had first fired "warning shots" at "suspects" approaching them.

When the individuals continued advancing, "an aircraft struck and eliminated the suspects in order to remove the threat," the army said.

Elsewhere in the territory on Friday, Bassal said 14 people were killed in two separate strikes in and around the central city of Deir el-Balah, and 13 others in three Israeli air strikes in the Gaza City area. AFP

LONDON: British police are searching for suspects and the military is reviewing security arrangements after pro-Palestinian activists broke into a Royal Air Force Base and damaged two planes with red paint. Two members entered RAF Brize Norton on Wednesday and used electric scooters to approach the Voyager jets.

Russian drones strike 2 Ukrainian cities, kill 1 as Zelenskyy urges less pressure

KYIV

RUSSIAN drones slammed into two Ukrainian cities, killing at least one person in nighttime attacks, authorities said Friday, as a Kremlin official said he expected an announcement next week on dates for a fresh round of direct peace talks.

Russia's overnight drone assault targeted the southern Ukraine port city of Odesa and the northeastern city of Kharkiv, hitting apartment blocks, officials said.

The barrage of more than 20 drones injured almost two dozen civilians, including girls aged 17 and 12, Ukraine President Volodymyr Zelenskyy said. "Russia continues its tactics of targeted terror against our people," Zelenskyy said on messaging app Telegram, urging the United States and the European Un-

ion to crank up economic pressure on Russia.

Russia has shown no signs of relenting in its attacks, more than three years after it invaded its neighbor. It is pressing a summer offensive on parts of the roughly 1,000-kilometer

(620-mile) front line and has kept up long-range strikes that have hit civilian areas. Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov said Friday that the date for the next round peace talks is expected to be agreed upon next week. AP

China sends 74 warplanes towards Taiwan

Taipei: China sent 74 warplanes toward Taiwan, 61 crossing the Taiwan Strait's median line, in a major show of force amid ongoing tensions. The move followed the transit of British naval ship HMS Spey, which Taiwan welcomed as support for international navigation rights. China condemned the British action and said it monitored the vessel. Taiwan responded to warplane incursion with ships, jets, and missile systems.

UK back terminally ill assisted death bill

London: UK lawmakers voted 314-291 to support the Terminally Ill Adults (End of Life) Bill, allowing terminally ill adults in England and Wales to choose assisted death. The bill applies to those over 18 with less than six months to live, who must be capable of self-administering the fatal drugs. The bill now moves to the House of Lords, which can amend or delay but not block it.
