

Amboli turns into monsoon delight, draws tourists in droves

Located 70 km from Belagavi, it is often referred to as 'Kingdom of Waterfalls'

REJUVENATED by the season's first spell of heavy rainfall, the scenic hill station of Amboli, located around 70 km from Belagavi, has turned into a monsoon wonderland, attracting tourists from Karnataka, Maharashtra, Goa, Andhra Pradesh, and other parts of India.

Often referred to as the "Kingdom of Waterfalls," Amboli has once again started drawing large crowds after captivating images of its mist-covered hills, gushing waterfalls, and verdant landscapes went viral on social media. The monsoon showers have breathed new life into the region, cloaking it in thick fog and lending it a dreamlike charm that visitors say feels "straight out of a fairytale."

The most prominent attraction is the giant roadside water-

fall along the Belagavi-Sawantwadi highway, which, although not fully recharged yet, has already begun to mesmerise tourists with its blooming beauty. Nearby, Kavale Shet, located about 13 km away, offers a breathtaking view of multiple waterfalls cascading down the forested hillsides. This lesser-known viewpoint is quickly gaining popularity, with visitors crowding the area despite intermittent showers and misty conditions.

Amboli is not just a destination for waterfall enthusiasts. The region boasts several nature-rich attractions including - Hiranya Keshi Temple, dedicated to Lord Shiva and situated by a sacred spring; Nagatra Falls, Mahadevgad Point, Narayangad Fort, and several other viewpoints that come alive during the monsoon.

The area is steeped in mythol-

ogy and spirituality, with 108 Shiva temples believed to be hidden in the surrounding forests, only a dozen have been discovered so far. Families with children can explore the Amboli Forest Park, a lush green space that serves as both a play area and a natural habitat for creatures like the Malabar Gliding Frog, adding an educational twist to the visit.

As the monsoon deepens and the waterfalls gather full strength, Amboli is expected to see a further rise in tourist numbers, reaffirming its status as one of the Western Ghats' top monsoon getaways.

SC upholds conviction in 30-yr-old bribery case, accused held

IN a landmark judgment, the Supreme Court has upheld the conviction passed by the Special Court in a 30-year-old bribery case, leading to the arrest of the accused official, Nagesh Dondu Shivangekar, a former Village Accountant from Kadoli village in Belagavi taluk.

The case dates back to 1995 when the Karnataka Lokayukta Police registered a trap case (Crime No. 06/1995) based on a complaint by Laxman Rukmanna Katambale of Kadoli village. The complainant does not exist at present. The complainant had alleged that the accused officer demanded a bribe of Rs 500 to issue land partition records (Geni and Pahan documents) related to ancestral property among the complainant's family members. Lokayukta officials caught Shivangekar red-handed while accepting the bribe and seized the money as evidence.

Following the investigation led by MS Dandin, then Deputy Superintendent of Police, Karnataka Lokayukta, Belagavi, a chargesheet was filed. The Special Court for Lokayukta cases (Special Case No. 97/1996) convicted the accused on June 14, 2006, and sentenced him to one year of rigorous imprisonment along with a fine of Rs 1,000. Shivangekar challenged the conviction in the High Court's Circuit Bench at Dharwad (Criminal Petition No. 1290/2006), which acquitted him and set aside the lower court's order on March 9, 2012.

However, the Karnataka Lokayukta challenged this acquittal in the Supreme Court through Criminal Appeal No. 773/2013. After years of legal proceedings, the apex court delivered its verdict on April 16, 2025, reinstating the conviction and upholding the Special Court's original judgment.

Acting on the Supreme Court's directive, the trial court issued an arrest warrant, and on June 18, 2025, Lokayukta officials arrested the 70-year-old Nagesh Dondu Shivangekar who retired from services 10 years ago. He was produced before the court and has now been remanded to judicial custody at the Hindalga Central Prison in Belagavi. This case marks a significant reaffirmation of accountability in public service, even decades after the crime.

Three held in mataka gambling crackdown in Belagavi

Belagavi: The city police arrested three individuals involved in the Mumbai Mataka game, seizing a total of Rs 5,110 in cash and gambling materials during two separate operations in Belagavi on Tuesday. In the first incident, Vinod Irranna Dodamani (21), a resident of Jyoti Nagar, Honga, was apprehended near Vitthal Mandir within Honga village limits. He was found accepting bets and recording numbers related to the Mataka game. Acting on the same, Shubhadha Nayak CHC and her team from Kakati Police Station seized Rs 2,560 in cash along with related materials. A case has been registered under Section 78(3) of the Karnataka Police Act. In another raid conducted the same evening around 6.20 pm, Nagesh Gudappa Ballodi (23) of Hale Peth Galli, Marihal, and Ningappa Yallappa Nesaragi (39) of Ankalgai, Gokak taluk, were caught gambling in public near Guddamadevi Temple Road in Marihal. PSI Chandrashekar and his team from Marihal Police Station seized Rs 2,550 and Mataka slips and pens from the duo. **ENS**

College student stabbed over bus window seat dispute

Belagavi: In a shocking incident at the Belagavi Central Bus Stand, an argument over a window seat escalated into violence, leaving a college student seriously injured after being stabbed by an unidentified youth with a sharp weapon. The altercation began when the accused got into a quarrel with the student over a window seat. The argument turned violent, and the youth allegedly stabbed the student in the chest before fleeing the scene. The injured student has been identified as Maaz Abdul Rasheed Sanadi (19), a BA second semester student from Lingaraj Degree College and resident of Pant Balekundri village in Belagavi taluk. He is currently receiving

treatment at the Belagavi Institute of Medical Sciences (BIMS) Hospital. Deputy Commissioner of Police (DCP) Rohan Jagadish visited the hospital and reviewed the situation. According to reports, the altercation started during the journey and culminated at the Central Bus Stand, where the stabbing occurred. The police have already traced the bus involved in the incident, and three special teams have been formed to identify and apprehend the accused. A case has been registered at Market Police Station. **ENS**
